Links to EYFS 1.4 Health and Well Being

All children are unwell from time to time as are adults and to avoid any epidemics within Wyetots, I ask exclusion periods of the following:-

Disease	Exclusion Period
Chicken Pox	For 5 days after the rash appears
Conjunctivitis	24 hours
Diarrhea and vomiting	Last bout 48 before returning
Impetigo	Lesions need to crust over
Measles	5 days after rash appears
Ringworm	Needs to be treated before return
Rubella	5 days after rash appears
Scabies	Until treated
Scarlet Fever	5 days after commencement of antibiotics
Whooping Cough	5 days after commencement of antibiotics
Head lice	Must be treated before your child returns

I ask you to put your child in your shoes. If you have had a nasty bug or cold and have generally felt ill and shivery etc, then the chances are that your child is feeling the same and needs a duvet day at home!

Don't forget as well, If I catch it, my children may catch it and then I may have to have time off which could prove inconvenient all round.
